Its opening to the sky indicates that both the imperial career comes from the heaven and the essence of heaven and earth and the enduring of the empire; when bronze is used as an instrument, it is cast into a bright, beautiful and special shape surrounded by lines. It is combined with birdsong; dance and other patterns play the clear, melodious and beautiful music to make the listeners are naturally happy and intoxicated. Pottery, for another example, is made into ladle for scooping water, urn for holding rice, jar for catching rain, because of its early roots in the rice culture and being made from earth. It can be seen that though its lines and modelings are relatively soft, they also change with the themes. Another example is jade. Because of its limited materials and mainly for decoration, its lines are generally smooth and modeling is generally small and exquisite. However, different themes determine different modelings and patterns of jade, like Buddhas and Bodhisattvas, various animal sculptures, zodiac signs, various jewelry and bracelets that people want to use to protect themselves.

In the long history of our country, our arts and crafts techniques and cultural and artistic connotation are also constantly improving. On the one hand, many ancient traditional arts and crafts have been inherited and developed, like bronze. People can now make copper, bronze, brass and other copper - based and different materials of craft works. Moreover, people can make modern copper arts and crafts with more colorful modelings and patterns, which can almost be designed, made and arranged on demand; On the other hand, many new kinds of arts and crafts have been developed, like porcelain developed from pottery, dyeing and weaving embroidery from weaving, lacquerware from wood products, and enamels and various sculptures. They have greatly enriched and developed the treasure house of traditional Chinese arts and crafts, and enabled it to have more extensive and far-reaching impact on people's aesthetic, beautified people's living and working environment.

Purpose of Interior Decoration Design and New Requirements for Traditional Arts and Crafts
